What is the source of the 5 mio. Euro mentioned in connection with the EFACEC deal?

The EFACEC deal is structured to maximize the benefits available from Australian Government R&D tax rebate and to make a significant part of the additional payment in the form of a user-royalty i.e. if the technology is utilized in Dyesol solar panels then Efacec will enjoy a small percentage of that revenue in the form of a royalty payment. When a total of €5 million is paid, the ownership of the technology will fully transfer to Dyesol.

Does the agreement with Tata influence collaboration with Tasnee? Does Tasnee intend to invest further or get involved in another way?

Any existing agreements with Tasnee and/or Tata are not in conflict and are non-exclusive. Dyesol cannot speak on behalf of Tasnee, however the possibility exists for collaboration with Tasnee in both in materials supply and access to Middle-Eastern PV markets.

Is Dyesol involved in the EU Graphene Flagship research program?

Dyesol has direct involvement with EU Graphene Flagship through Dyesol Italia.
